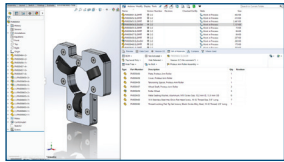

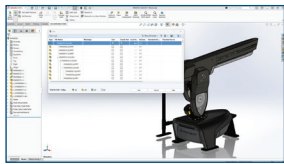


1 Improved Bill of Materials Visualization

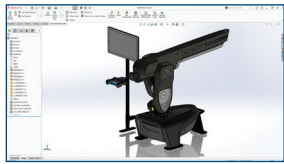


2 Increased Flexibility for Caching Data

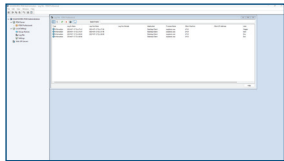


3 Better User Experience

Bypass the Task Pane for accessing commands with an increased graphics area.

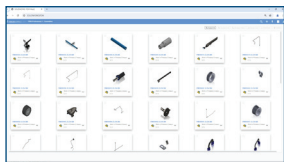


4 Increased User Tracking
